- Properly certified as a minority, women or LGBT owned, operated, managed and controlled (51% or more) firm. **Must be certified by the National Minority Supplier Development Council (NMSDC), the Women's Business Enterprise National Council (WBENC), or The National Gay and Lesbian Chamber of Commerce (NGLCC).**

- Demonstrated commitment to inclusion and diversity in the legal profession.
- Favorable client references from national and regional corporations or major public entities, including corporate references within the Fortune 500.
